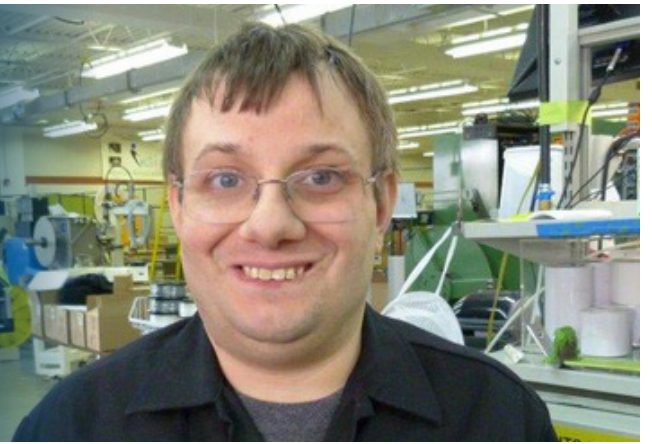


LAWRENCE
