Her position in the Housekeeping/Laundry department is one of the essential services to ensure the facility stays clean and the residents stay healthy. Being able to help in this busy department is what makes Shelbey feel valued.

Shelbey was hired in May with the help of a job coach, who is supported by Geauga DD. She has had opportunities to work in different positions but said the Laundry department fit her best. "I like helping. I like working with people and being around people. I laugh a lot with my coworkers while folding linens, and delivering the linen cart."

Shelbey's boss Brianna, had nothing but praise for her. "Shelbey is always willing to take on new tasks. Anything that's asked of her, she completes in a timely manner. She has taken on the task of bringing clean mops and rags to our housekeeping supply closet and stocking the mops and rags on the shelf for staff. She has independently made this her own task without asking! It's great to see her come into her own and be proactive without any guidance.

At any work place, curveballs are always thrown into the mix. She's flexible and reliable when emergencies come up and I need to pull staff away from laundry to help with something else. She knows the expectation and goals set for laundry and when you assign her a job she completes it, even if other staff members are not around."

Brianna went on to say, "Shelbey brings positivity to our department; she keeps the girls in laundry smiling and laughing with her stories. It's nice to see her blossom to be independent. Her willingness and drive to be out in the community working sets a great tone and example for others. She has been nothing less than amazing. She's a rock star!!"
