# NEW PLAYGROUND

The Metzenbaum Center has a brand-new playground that is accessible and fun for everyone! The new playground is always open to the public from dawn to dusk, seven days a week. Our previous playground was nearly 30 years old, was rusty in many spots, and didn't have much for kids who use wheelchairs or other mobility devices. In early 2021, the Geauga County Board of DD recognized the need for something new, so they authorized a committee to start the design process. Later in 2021 all the aging, cracked sidewalks were replaced with a wide, smooth walking path that encircles the whole playground area. We also added a shade pavilion with picnic tables. In 2022, designs for the new playground were finalized, with a focus on creating LOTS of options for everyone: sensory items, musical instruments, accessible areas, and traditional climbing/sliding options. We even have an accessible merry go ground! Supply chain problems pushed construction back to the end of 2022, with the finishing touches happening in the spring of 2023.
